Our goal is to make LHN an affordable educational experience for families wishing to receive an exceptional Christian private school education. Our Financial Assistance Program is designed to make tuition affordable with several payment options:

Option One – Tuition Payment Plan

Payment options include:

- Pre-payment in full
- 10 month payment: June - March

All monthly tuition is billed through F.A.C.T.S. Tuition Management

Option Two – Financial Aid

Once a child has been accepted for enrollment, LHN has a financial aid program to support families who need assistance. LHN is committed to meeting 100% of every family's demonstrated financial need.

How do I apply?

Applications for tuition assistance are available in the school office and should be submitted to the Admissions Office once the child has been accepted to LHN. We adhere to a needs-blind admissions policy, meaning that a family's ability to pay tuition and fees is not a factor in the admissions decision.

Do I qualify?

Each family's situation is unique, and the ability of a family to contribute financially is based on many factors, such as combined salary, available assets, or number of children in tuition required schools. In order to determine a family's ability to pay tuition, families are asked to complete a Tuition Assistance Application and return it to the Admissions Office. LHN also requires that both parents, regardless of marital status, submit original tax returns.

Option Three – Congregational Student Assistance

Students who are active, participating members of one of the Association member congregations listed below are eligible to apply for tuition assistance through their congregation. The amount of congregational assistance and requirements vary by congregation. In order to receive Congregational Student Assistance you must:

- Complete the LHN enrollment application
- Complete the Congregational Assistance application
- Submit the application to your pastor for signature and submission
